At its meeting on 5 February 2017, the Executive Committee of the Association agreed that the replacement of the local doctor was outside its capacity. It was agreed that Council would still be asked if there were any sites where zoning would allow the establishment of a practice and Tim would talk to Darryl Leslight about the conditions required for a practice to be established at the shops.

The meeting was concerned to ensure that the local pharmacy would remain in business and agreed that it was unlikely that the doctor's departure would have a major impact on business.

7. Reports

7.1 Shorebirds and Graffiti

The following Reports have been received from Marg Hamon

Shorebird Report - Bawley Point/Kioloa Area

This season has not been a very successful one for the Hooded Plovers. We started monitoring the pair J7 and B0 in August, but it wasn't until 11/10 that they laid their first eggs on Murramarang Beach. This nest was taken by a fox on 25/10. The pair then moved to Avenue Beach at Kioloa and nested again on 13/11. This nest, in spite of being caged, was taken by an unknown predator, probably a bush rat, on 25/11. They then moved to Racecourse Beach and made another nest on 14/12. This was also taken by a fox. It has been a bad year for fox predation right up and down the coast. At the time of writing this pair doesn't seem to have another nest, but will be monitored as it is still possible they could try again.

Meanwhile, at Dawson's Beach (four beaches south of Pretty) the pair H7 and M4 nested on 12/10/17 and hatched 2 chicks from 3 eggs on 3/12/17. One chick disappeared on 17/12 but the other survived to fledge, we hope. At the time it was expected to fledge the coast was hit by a big swell and king tides, making the area too difficult to access. The sea also wiped out a Red-capped Plover nest on Island Beach. Island Beach was also the site for a Pied Oystercatcher nest in August 2017. This nest was lost just before hatching, possibly to a fox.

There are some more fledglings in the South Coast area, but both eggs and chicks elsewhere were impacted by the cold weather and enormous swells.

Graffiti Report

The good news is that there has been relatively little graffiti over the holiday season, just some minor scrawls on signs, mainly at Mudholes and Sandmines car parks. There is also some on a rock at Mudholes which we haven't been able to remove. The main incident came after the holidays, with the WIRES sign on Bawley Point Rd being defaced. Luckily it was easily cleaned off. Don't forget we have a Parkcare/Graffiti team in our area so please report any graffiti so it can be dealt with swiftly.

7.2 Bawley Pt and Kioloa Bushcare Groups - Update

The following Report has been received from Sybille Davidson

During 2016 – 17 our small bands of bushcarers have continued to make inroads into the invasive species that turn up in our remnant patches of Council-managed bushland reserves. We combat exotic weeds invading these patches, often as a result of garden waste dumpings; seed is also spread by birds and wind.

The B Pt group usually meets once a month, teaming up with Cate Brooks, our Council support staffer who brings with her appropriate environmental credentials. When carrying out bushcare weeding it is important to correctly identify the target weeds and become familiar with the most effective tactics for each species. Our main focus areas are remnant patches of native bushland that are basically in good nick and just needing an occasional re-visit. We prioritise bushland designated as EEC (Endangered Environmental Community) and nearby areas. Our usual sites are: Bangalay Sand Forest at Gannet and Cormorant Beaches; the wetland periphery close to Cormorant Beach, and the Willinga Lake catchment at the edge of Shearwater Crescent. These are sites that suffer from inappropriate garden waste dumping – or have in the past.

Over some years we are pleased to note at these sites that we have had some good successes; we have substantially reduced the occurrence of many invading exotic garden escapees such as Asparagus fern, Bridal Creeper, Cassia, Creeping Charlie, English Ivy, German Ivy, Dolichos Pea, Formosa Lily, Sailor Boy Daisies, Spider Plant, Agapanthus and Fishbone Fern. One species that is frustratingly persistent is Mother-of-Millions, a succulent from Madagascar that can poison horses and cattle. It turns up not only in sand vegetation near beaches, but also on all of our rocky headlands. We have reduced its density in many sites, but there are still a lot of pockets of this menace that bounce back when you are "not looking".

Council gives us backing in the form of a regular paid support officer, equipment, occasional extra contracted workers for designated broad scale weed treatments, and support in seeking funding for bigger projects (we sought and were successful in 2008-9).

The Kioloa group meets at various times, as notified by Barbara White. Barbara and her troops have been waging an unrelenting war on *Aristea ecklonii* (the blue flowering lily from Sth Africa), Formosa Lilies, Asparagus fern and Cassia, where they have invaded in hind dune reserves and O'Hara Headland, but also along village surrounds.

If you are interested in helping to retain the integrity of our native bushland patches near our beach reserves, please join us for a couple of hours about once a month. The B Pt group usually convenes on a Monday afternoon.

For enquiries about either group please call Sybille Davidson 0488 274527. We can arrange for you to register as a bushcare volunteer, for either Bawley Pt or Kioloa (Registration as a bushcarer is essential for clearing any vegetation in our reserves). May we also suggest – Please don't plant invasive exotic species in your garden; they can and do escape into the bush. Grow Natives instead! Check out the Milton-U'dulla Landcare Nursery in Deering St.

Most especially we remind owners and residents (and their garden maintenance contractors) that the dumping of ANY garden waste, including lawn clippings, is not only totally illegal, it is a disaster for our lovely bushland.

Absentee property owners!!! Do you know where YOUR mowing/gardening contractor disposes of YOUR lawn clippings?

MONDAY 20 November 2017

Meeting of the Committee held at the Community centre at 7.45 pm

PRESENTATION

The meeting commenced with a presentation by Russell Clifton, Captain, Kioloa RFS, and Charlie Magnusson, Captain, Bawley Point RFS, on emergency preparations for the coming summer.

Both Captains noted that the RFS teams were now carrying a range of activities for their local communities that were hitherto undertaken by town brigades. It was pleasing to see interest in the RFS continuing with three new cadets. It was noted that the Emergency community Meeting points were Bawley Point headland and the ANU Campus in Kioloa.

Charlie reminded the meeting that the Bawley Point RFS Christmas part would be held on 3 December.

Members noted that the Fire Danger advisory sign had been removed from the road leading into Bawley Point and asked that it be replaced.

5. General Business

5.1. Dog Sign Proposal

The Dog Sign has been installed at Bawley Point shops as suggested by the Committee

5.2 Healthy Steps Program

It was noted that signs for a measured (200 m intervals) kilometre had been installed leading from the shops to Rosemary Avenue.

5.3 *Community Connect*

Barrie noted that there had been progress but there was an urgent need to get volunteers (especially young ones!). Council has surveyed the proposed path and identified the more difficult areas. There was a suggestion that the current team should prepared the site but then get professionals in to undertake the actual pour.

5.4 NBN / Mobile Black Spot Update

The following update by Barrie Ellis was noted:

NBN:

There continues to be a mixed bag of experience with NBN in the Village. Most people have struggled to get connected although there have been some who have had initial success.

The ACCC has interceded with the Telcos effectively to stop them selling bandwidth speeds that they knew were not supported by the underlying NBN infrastructure. As a result Telstra is in the process of refunding money to customers it has misled.

Kioloa:

NBN has advised that it will commence work laying a fibre cable between the Bawley Point Exchange in Thrush street to an end node in Kioloa. Presumably close the the Telstra end node opposite Merry Street.

This technology build will allow NBN to deliver fibre to the node similar the strategy implemented in Bawley Point.

Summary: Where possible I would encourage the community to leave off joining NBN until you absolutely have to and allow the initial bedding in period to resolve many of the current issues.

In view of the impending tower build in Kioloa(see below) one should not dismiss the potential of wireless broadband becoming a competitor to land line based systems in the near future.

Mobile Blackspot:

Vision Stream is the subcontractor responsible for identifying, contracting and subsequently building base stations for this program. Telstra is responsible for installing/ maintaining the transmission equipment.

In discussions with Steve Berkhout he has informed me that the necessary paper work is in place to allow further technical evaluation of the ANU site adjacent to the current transmission pole near Steve's house.

I am not aware of any other discussions with property owners in the area. However as those arrangements are "commercial in confidence" it is not to say that there are not other sites going through the same process as the ANU.

If the ANU site is technically feasible and commercial terms can be successfully negotiated, then Telstra's schedule to build and commission a site in the early part of 2018 will be met. It will also require conversations with Council who in turn will start the appropriate consultations with our Community through the CCB.

5.5. Junction of Bawley Point Road and Princes Highway

It was noted that the danger at the junction of Bawley Point Road and Princes Highway caused by heavy vehicles parking on the opposite side of the road from the Service Station and impeding the view of south-bound traffic on the Highway had been raised by Barrie with the appropriate officer in Council who has undertaken to put the issue to RMS. As Barrie had noted, RMS tends to be a law unto itself

5.6 Viewing Platform - Gannet Beach

It was noted that member of the community had suggested the building of a viewing platform with appropriate access/egress at Gannett Beach to allow access for disabled members of the community to, for example, watch family members swimming/surfing on Gannet beach. As an aside, a platform would also contribute to safety by allowing oversight of one of the main swimming beaches in the area. Platforms at Broadbeach, might provide appropriate models

In the meantime, Council has constructed a small viewing platform on the south side of Gannet Beach as part of "Beach-Scaping".

5.7 Councillors Visit

Council had advised that the annual Councillors Visit which was scheduled for 26 November was now postponed to a date to be set in February 2018. As in the past the Committee will prepare a list of talking points to be sent to Councillors in advance with the state of the Community's roads being a major issue identified. No other specific items were raised

5.8 Provision of exercise equipment and fitness posts across the area

The Committee proposes to explore the possibility of installing exercise equipment at fitness posts through the area. It was suggested that these would be acquired on a

modular basis and be located in the Bawley Point Reserve. While members thought the matter could be explored it was strongly suggested that the Pathway was the priority

5.9 Possible installation of a pedestrian crossing on Murramarang Road between the shops and the footpath

The proposal was unanimously rejected as unsafe

6. New and Other Business

6.1 Gantry Fund

It was noted that because the Gantry had been rebuilt, the Sporting Fishers Grant was required to be returned, less \$15K already expended. There was comment on the unauthorised access by cars and at the suggestion of Jocelyn and Euan Sussman, it was agreed to pressure Council to ensure that barrier rocks were firmly fixed and that the area was patrolled more regularly

6.2 Retirement of Local Doctor

Jocelyn noted that Scott Brown was retiring and believed that the Community needed to work towards a replacement for him. There is an issue in that the current practice is classified as a "Home Business" so it cannot be sold or leased. Jocelyn suggested a number of possibilities:

- that practices in Ulladulla or Milton be asked whether they would locate a practitioner to the area;
- that the ANU be asked whether it might establish a practice at the Campus in conjunction with the Medical School;
- that the community advertise in medical journals

MOTION That the Association mobilise opinion and take steps work with Council and local members to ensure that the Bawley Kioloa community continue to enjoy the benefits of a local general practitioner
